
OBSIDIAN



Volcanic Estate Cabernet Sauvignon
OBSIDIAN RIDGE VINEYARD | RED HILLS LAKE COUNTY

WHAT Single Vineyard Cabernet grown at ~3,000 feet elevation on the side of a volcano.

WHERE The far northern tip of the Mayacamas Mountain Range, on a steep, north-facing slope on a flow of solid black obsidian glass.

WHO Founded 25 years ago by Peter Molnar, Arpad Molnar, and Michael Terrien when they found an abandoned walnut orchard on a ridge of glass a half mile high in the sky.

WHY Volcanic wines are just different. There is a tension, an intensity from growing on the edge.

NOTE Distinct volcanic, high-elevation character—intense color, aroma and flavor, with a freshness and minerality that typifies the site.

PAIRING Exceptionally food-friendly—ideal for guests who want a lot of flavor to pair with a range. Especially loves fire flavors - grill, roast, sear.



Obsidian Estate Chardonnay POSEIDON VINEYARD | CARNEROS, NAPA VALLEY

WHAT 100% Estate grown chardonnay aged in large format Hungarian oak barrels and casks.

WHERE Poseidon Vineyard, the southernmost point of Carneros Napa Valley, where the gravelly foot of the Mayacamas Mountains meets the San Pablo Bay.

WHO Obsidian Wine Co was founded 25 years ago by Peter Molnar, Arpad Molnar, and Michael Terrien. The Molnars' parents escaped Hungary in 1956 and planted Poseidon Vineyard in 1973.

WHY We were coopers before winemakers. We began making wine to demonstrate how Hungarian oak complements chardonnay.

VIBE Crisp, fresh, and vibrant, this is not your typical CA chardonnay. Citrusy aromas and flavors, yet luscious and smooth.

PAIRING Has the fresh acidity and intense flavors to stand up to cream, butter and fat, but also the sophistication and minerality for lighter fare. Shellfish is a home run.

DIGITS 14.0% abv, 3,000 cases produced.







Obsidian Estate Pinot Noir
POSEIDON VINEYARD | CARNEROS, NAPA VALLEY

WHAT Estate Grown Pinot Noir, 10% whole cluster fermented; aged in large-format Hungarian oak barrels and casks.

WHERE Poseidon Vineyard, the southernmost point of Carneros Napa Valley, where the gravelly foot of the Mayacamas Mountains meets the San Pablo Bay.

WHO Obsidian Wine Co was founded 25 years ago by Peter Molnar, Arpad Molnar, and Michael Terrien. The Molnars' parents escaped Hungary in 1956 and planted Poseidon Vineyard in 1973.

WHY For 50 years, we have grown Martini clone Pinot Noir for the finest sparkling houses in Napa Valley. We reserve the most intense rows for ourselves to make this classically-styled Estate Pinot Noir.

NOTE A delicate, pretty wine with a medium body, fresh acidity, and beguiling intricacy.
Classic floral and bright fruit, with a touch of tea leaf from stems and warm spice and earth from Hungarian oak.

PAIRING Pairs with literally everything savory.

DIGITS 13.4% abv, 1,145 cases produced.

Triple Junction Volcanic Red

WASHINGTON | OREGON | CALIFORNIA

WHAT Red blend from three distinct volcanic sites across three states showcases West Coast Volcanic character: intensity, tension, minerality.

WHERE Three volcanic sites: Basalt rock in Red Mountain, Washington; Mazama Ash in Columbia Valley Oregon, and Obsidian glass on our Estate in Northern California.

WHO Founded 25 years ago by Peter Molnar, Arpad Molnar, and Michael Terrien when they found an abandoned walnut orchard on a ridge of glass a half mile high in the sky..

WHY We ventured northward to explore the chain of volcanoes formed by the collision of 3 tectonic plates, aka the Triple Junction.

NOTE A Cabernet-driven blend that highlights the volcanic nature of all three sites: minerality, freshness & structure.

DIGITS 50% Cabernet, 27% Malbec, 15% Petite Sirah, 8% Tempranillo 14.0% abv, 1,500 cases produced.
